## Canadian competition team

Registration is \$50 for the first two divisions and \$15 for each additional. All competitor fees go to support the WMO Canadian competition team as they represent Canada in Portugal, this year in late September.

Spectators can buy a ticket online for \$5 and bring a non-perishable food item on the day of the event. Food items will be donated to support local food banks.



## Divisions

Age groups will be divided into 8 and under, 9-12, 13-17 (sparring divisions will be divided into 13-15 and 16-17), 18-35, 35-49 and 50+. Competitors can compete in the Black-belt/all-belt divisions or colour-belt divisions. In order to be considered for the team, competitors must place in the top 3 of their black-belt/all-belt division. 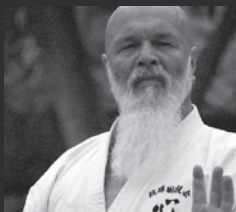
